Dear Friends,

Since 1909, the volunteer-organized Charity Ball committee has put children first. Given the continued challenges posed by the coronavirus pandemic, for the first time since 1946, we will not gather for the traditional Charity Ball this February.

Instead we will achieve our mission by focusing our fundraising on the **112th Anniversary Charity Ball Special Edition Program**, which will debut in February 2021. We invite you to join us as a sponsor, advertiser or underwriter. Throughout the years, the Charity Ball Program has chronicled the philanthropic spirit of the Charity Ball, as well as a fascinating history of families and businesses. During this year of critical need, we value your support more than ever.

We have worked closely with Rady Children's Hospital-San Diego to identify where we can do the most immediate good. Before the outbreak of COVID-19, San Diego's children already were in a mental health crisis. The pandemic has made it significantly worse. We know that caring for the whole child, by providing early intervention, we can reduce the long-term impact of untreated mental health issues later in life. Half of all mental illness occurs before the age of 14, and 75 percent by age 24.

Your participation in the 112th Anniversary Charity Ball Special Edition Program will support Behavioral Health programs and services at Rady Children's Hospital-San Diego, providing a myriad of critical services and therapies to address the escalation of mental health concerns facing our children and teens. Because of COVID, there are additional pressures placed on young people caused by social isolation and abrupt changes in family and social dynamics resulting in increased anxiety, depression and suicidal ideation.

This year, your gift to Rady Children's Behavioral Health programs through the Charity Ball will go even further by unlocking **two** matching gifts. All gifts will be matched by a special Hospital fund, doubling the impact of your gift to behavioral health programs. In addition, your gift will unlock even more funds, thanks to Ernest and Evelyn Rady who pledged \$200 million to Rady Children's in November 2019. 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
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We are in crisis.

Every hour of every day children and teens come to Rady Children's in need of immediate mental health care.

In 2010, 40 children a month were seen in Rady Children's emergency department in crisis. Today that number is nearly 400 children a month.

Teen suicide is on the rise across the country, and San Diego has the highest incidence in the state of children and teens ending their lives.

In California, more than 1.5 million people experience extreme adversity during their childhoods which can have devastating implications throughout adulthood.

Before the outbreak of COVID-19 we already were deep in this crisis.

Abuse.

Neglect.

Bullying.

Anxiety.

Self-harm.

Depression.

Suicide.


The pandemic has made it worse.

While children have been spared the majority of physical health complications caused by COVID-19, a second pandemic has the potential to have life-altering consequences: a steep rise in unaddressed mental health needs.

Mental and behavioral health concerns and child abuse incidents have increased since we've been sheltering in place. During school closures, kids and teens have not had access to school-based mental health screenings or intervention services. Adults who may notice signs of trouble at home are no longer able to observe the signals. Simply put, the pandemic has amplified mental health concerns. Peer support groups and in-person check-ins have disappeared. Children find themselves isolated, fearful and experiencing feelings of increased anxiety with reduced options for help.

The stress of social isolation can have long-term detrimental outcomes. Children are dealing with profound separation from friends, family and teachers, causing them to experience:

- Mounting fear and anxiety about their own health and that of their loved ones
- Changes in eating and sleeping patterns



- Concerns about falling behind in school
- An increase use of alcohol, tobacco and other substances; and
- Escalating feelings of isolation, hopelessness, frustration or anger

Rady Children's pediatric mental health care providers expect to see a surge in the number of children who require treatment following the pandemic. They also know that early intervention can help stem the long-term consequences of untreated mental health concerns that can cause physical health issues in adulthood as severe as obesity and heart disease.

The development of a comprehensive matrix of prevention, intervention programs, scientific study, education and training is needed—for our children and families, communities and health care providers. Rady Children's is expertly poised to wrap existing expertise in diagnosis, clinical care, research and treatment programs around a compassion-based, comprehensive behavioral health care model within its renowned pediatric health care system.

You can positively alter life trajectories for millions of children worldwide by providing frontline abuse and trauma prevention programs and launching mental health intervention programs first in San Diego, which will be modeled in other communities. Your gift will enable children to live their best lives.

Your support through our 112th Anniversary Charity Ball Special Edition Program will serve as a beacon to children and families seeking guidance through some of the most complex child health issues. Together, through the generous spirit and tradition of the Charity Ball, we will directly address the mental health crisis gripping our children and provide intervention, treatment and a path to the bright future they deserve, long after the pandemic is over.
